

Cedar Rapids Transit Stroller & Grocery Cart Policy



For safety purposes, passengers must keep the bus aisle and doorways clear of all items including strollers, grocery carts, and personal possessions.

➤ Effective June 1, 2015:

- □The wheelchair seating areas are reserved for passengers with disabilities with ADA mobility devices such as wheelchairs or walkers.
- □ Passengers with strollers and grocery carts are prohibited from using the wheelchair seating areas even when those areas are not occupied.
- □All children and/or possessions, such as groceries, must be removed from strollers and grocery carts and the strollers/carts collapsed and stored out of the aisle and doorways.
- □Passengers will not be allowed to board with large strollers or other items that cannot be collapsed and safely stored.
- □Passengers are limited to items that can be contained in their personal space which is no more than their seat and the adjacent seat.
